

Notice of Race

Women On Water Zonie Regatta
Hosted by Tumbleweed Racing
November 1-3, 2019, Lake Pleasant, Arizona

1. RULES

1.1. All races will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS 2017-2020).

2. FLEETS

2.1. There will be a minimum of 2 fleets racing:

- Phrf Non-spinnaker
- Phrf Spinnaker
- Others TBD as needed

2.2. Boats and equipment will be provided by Tumbleweed Sailing.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. This event is an open event to any women who wish to participate. *Newcomers and visitors are welcomed.*

3.2. **Early Registration** must be completed at tumbleweedsailing.com/wowzr/ & must be received by midnight, Sept. 30, 2019.

3.3. **General registration** must be completed at tumbleweedsailing.com/wowzr/ & must be received **by midnight, Oct. 27, 2019.**

4. **FEES** - Includes all activities & meals a Pleasant Harbor marina entry pass for 3 days. Fees do not include lodging expenses. Early registration is from Aug. 1st to Sept. 30th, 2019. Registration is from October 1 – October 25th.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

5.1. **Friday, November 1, 2019**, At 1700 there will be a Lake Pleasant orientation including hazards and local knowledge at the Lake Pleasant Activities Center (LPAC - AKA the

Anchor Drop) at Spinnaker Point. This will be followed by a spaghetti dinner and social networking time.

5.2. **Saturday, November 2, 2019** After a hot breakfast at the LPAC, seminars designed for anyone from beginners to advanced sailors will be offered. See the event schedule for more details on the seminars.

- Lunch will be provided at the LPAC.
- After lunch participants will make their way (via a shuttle) to the boats for an afternoon of sailing to familiarize themselves with the boats, practice, and to complete checkouts per the event schedule. Boats will return to the docks by 1700.
- Dinner and social time will be at the LPAC from 1800 to 2000. A brief Skipper's Meeting at 2000 will be followed by a video review of the afternoon's events with critique and Q&A as necessary.

5.3 Sunday, November 3, 2019

Continental breakfast will be provided at the LPAC from 0700 to 0730. Free shuttles will be available following breakfast to take people to the docks.

- Racing will begin at 0915. No warning signals shall be made after 1355. Shuttles will again be available to take people up to the LPAC.
- Lunch, social time and the awards will begin immediately following the last fleet finish of the day.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions are available at tumbleweedsailing.com/wowzr/. Changes to Sailing Instructions will be noted on-line by 0830 Sunday. The Regatta Chairperson will provide printed copies upon request.

7. ALTERATIONS TO RULES

STARTING RACES: fleet boards may be substituted for class flags depending on the committee boat being used. This may modify rule 26.

8. SAFETY REGULATIONS

It is mandatory that life jackets be worn at all times for all on-the-water events at this regatta.

9. COURSES TO BE SAILED

9.1. The race area and courses to be sailed are shown on the WOWZR Lake Pleasant Chart at tumbleweedsailing.com/wowzr/

10. SCORING

10.1. One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10.2. A boat starting later than fifteen (15) minutes after her starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start" (DNS). This changes rule A4.2

10.3. A boat may retire (RET) from a race and receive a score equal to the number of starters for that race, except if she starts alone in her fleet she shall sail the entire course to be scored as a finishing boat. This changes rule A4.1

10.4. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat in their fleet finishes will be scored "Time Limit Expired" (TLE). Boats identified TLE shall be scored points equal to the number of boats finishing within the time limit plus one point. This changes rule A4.

10.5. Scoring for the Awards will be based on scores for EVERY race divided by the number of races. If 5 or more races are run, 1 throw-out will be allowed.

11. PRIZES

11.1. First, second and third places will be awarded for each FLEET.
